LEISURE TIME RV PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

- Please keep your site clean. Do not Clean fish at your site — use the fish cleaning facility at the Park entrance area.
- Please observe the 5 MPH SPEED LIMIT AND WATCH FOR CHILDREN.
- QUIET HOURS are 10 PM to 7 AM. Guests are not allowed to stay after midnight unless they are registered at the office to stay overnight.
- Rowdiness, public intoxication, foul language, loud talking, inappropriate conduct and other disruptive actions will not be tolerated
- Children must be in their own campsite at dark or with an adult. Parents must assume full responsibility for their children's conduct and safety.
- No climbing of trees or shrubs.
- No skateboards on the blacktop.
- Pets must ALWAYS be on a leash that is 6 feet or shorter. Pets are not allowed in the laundry room, restrooms, or park office. They are not to be left unattended at any time. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR OWN PET.
- Please do not wash or rinse wetsuits in the laundry or restrooms
- Please empty portable holding tanks at the dump station.
- One car per site. Due to prior reservations you may be asked to move to another space.
- Rent must be paid on due date or a \$60 late charge will be added.
- No tents are allowed in RV sites.
- Except for residents who work night shifts, traffic within the Park must be curtailed between 10 PM and 7 AM. Casual visitors are not permitted. Any infraction of these rules will be met with one warning; if it reoccurs, a notice to vacate will be given.
- Restrooms, showers, and laundry rooms are for guest use ONLY. Do not share facility access codes with anyone.
- Fort Bragg Leisure Time RV Park reserves the right to evict any person for improper conduct or violating park rules and regulations. You will be asked to leave without a refund.
